***The Bronx did not exist as a separate borough until 1898. New York City (Manhattan) annexed the area west of the Bronx River in 1874 and annexed the area east of the Bronx River in 1895. For vital records for those areas after the date of annexation through 1897, request a search of Manhattan records.
